In 1993, Jim Valvano announced the beginning of the V Foundation for Cancer Research at the ESPYS, delivering an iconic speech to accept the Arthur Ashe Courage Award. While Jim was going through treatment, he recognized the vital need for researchers to receive funding. As he said: "We need your help. I need your help. We need money for cancer research. It may not save my life. It may save my children's lives. It may save someone you love." Since that time, we have worked tirelessly to accelerate the pace toward achieving Jim's dream of Victory Over Cancer®.

The research funded by the V Foundation is changing the cancer landscape and producing breakthroughs in cancer prevention, treatment, and remission. We are guided by our dedicated board of directors and world-class Scientific Advisory Committee which helps us remain selective, forward thinking, and determined in how we fund more research across all cancer types. Our funding model is unique and ensures the momentum in science continues. We are excited to say that research is working. The cancer death rate has continued to decline, contributing to a 33% overall reduction since 1991. While the numbers are heading in the right direction, and we are making great strides, there is much more to be done.

In 2022, we awarded nearly \$27 million in cancer research grants, bringing our total to over \$310 million to date. This translates to 1,186 cancer research grants that have been funded since Jim delivered that speech. Thanks to you — our dedicated donors and partners — we've awarded grants to more than 163 institutions in the U.S. and 4 institutions in Canada. In addition, the V Foundation has received 11 consecutive 4-star ratings from Charity Navigator, which places our organization among the top 2% of all charities evaluated. We are strong stewards of your dollars, maximizing our 100% pledge.

I invite you to learn more about our success during our last fiscal year and hope that you will join us on our continued crusade. Our rally cry remains strong: "Don't Give Up... Don't Ever Give Up!". And we won't. Because today's cancer research is tomorrow's victory.






