All-Star Eligibility Guide

Use this handout to confirm your nominee's eligibility for the V Foundation's All-Star grant. Review the corresponding Request for Application (RFA) for full details. For further questions, visit our [FAQ page](#) or email grants@v.org.

Start here:

Is the nominee currently an All-Star Grant recipient?

→ **Yes** – ineligible to apply.

No – continue to next question.

Is the nominee a U.S. citizen or legally permitted (temporary or permanent) to work in the U.S.?

→ **No** – ineligible to apply.

**This requirement does not apply to invited Canadian institutions.*

Yes – continue to next question.

Does the nominee hold a full-time faculty appointment at the Assistant Professor or Assistant Professor- equivalent level or above?

→ **No** – ineligible to apply.

** Non-promutable, adjunct, affiliated, temporary, part-time or acting faculty positions are ineligible.*

Yes – continue to next question.

Has the nominee received a V Foundation **research** grant?

→ **No** – ineligible to apply.

**Mission grants support educational projects and grantees that have only received Mission grants are ineligible.*

Yes – continue to next question.

Was the nominee the **lead** PI for their V Foundation research grant?

→ **No** – ineligible to apply.

**Individuals who served previously only as Co-PIs are ineligible.*

Yes – continue to next question.

Did the nominee serve as the original **lead** PI on their V Foundation research grant from start to finish?

→ **No** – ineligible to apply.

Yes – continue to next question.

Has the PI completed the V Foundation grant or entered the final year of the grant? For active one-year grants, has at least 75% of the awarded funds been expended?

→ **No** – ineligible to apply.

Yes – the nominee would be considered eligible to apply.
