

# Here's Julio César Chávez Jr. vs Jake Paul 2 LIVE Online fight time, date, how to watch Free ON TV CHANNEL - Dec 21, 2024

20 seconds ago — Jake Paul vs. Julio Cesar Chavez Jr. live round-by-round updates for one of the most anticipated boxing fights of the year at the Honda Center in Anaheim, Calif., on Saturday night.



The main event is expected to begin around 11:30 p.m. ET on DAZN pay-per-view. Check out our Paul vs. Chavez Jr. results to find out what happened on the undercard.

Jake Paul (11-1, 7 knockouts) has won five fights in a row, including a decision win over 58-year-old Mike Tyson in his last fight this past November.

Julio Cesar Chavez Jr. (54-6-1, 1 no-contest, 34 knockouts) has won two straight fights, including a decision win over UFC veteran Uriah Hall this past July.

Paul's antics were seen as mildly amusing when he took down an out-of-shape Ben Askren, a hampered Tyron Woodley, an ill-prepared Nate Diaz and even a 47-year old Anderson Silva, but then he came for Mike Tyson. The bleak sight of the legendary heavyweight pulling all of his punches in service to Paul's ego was too much for many, but it's surely a matter of time before the professional provocateur picks the wrong target.

Is Chavez Jr that guy? The Mexican is the son of boxing royalty in former three-division world champion Julio Cesar Chavez, but having last contested a serious belt 13 years ago, the 39-year-old's best days are clearly long gone. He also lost to Silva shortly before Paul beat the former UFC champ. Chavez Jr is, however, coming off consecutive victories over David Zegarra and Uriah Hall.

Catalogued as "absurd", the boxing fight that has generated curiosity in the world of pugilism has finally arrived. YouTuber-turned-boxer Jake Paul returns to the ring after defeating Mike Tyson last November and this time he will face former WBC middleweight champion Julio Cesar Chavez Jr. on Saturday, June 28 at the Honda Center in Anaheim, California.

The fight is scheduled for 10 rounds at a maximum weight of 200 pounds where the Cruiserweight belt will be at stake. Jake Paul, who will come in with credentials of 11 wins, seven by KO, and only one loss, will have as his opponent the Junior of the

Mexican legend, Julio Cesar Chavez, with extensive experience of 61 fights, of which 54 were victories, six defeats and one draw

‘The Problem Child’ is back in the ring for the first time since his eight-round decision victory over heavyweight legend Mike Tyson on Netflix in November, a damp squib of a contest that never came close to meeting its significant hype as former YouTube star Paul won at a canter against an opponent more than 30 years his senior.

The much-hyped and delayed stadium spectacle received plenty of criticism in its aftermath, though was watched by around 60 million households worldwide and reportedly netted Paul a cool \$40m.

His choice of opponents has once again been in the spotlight since, with arch-rival Tommy Fury - to whom he suffered his first and only loss to date - and the little-known pair of Andre August and Ryan Bourland still the only active boxers that Paul has faced during his 12-fight professional career so far, to go along with ex-UFC fighters like Mike Perry, Nate Diaz, Anderson Silva, Tyron Woodley and Ben Askren, plus former basketball player Nate Robinson and YouTuber AnEsonGib.

Paul appears to have tried to find something of a middle ground in a 10-round cruiserweight battle against Chavez Jr, the former WBC middleweight world champion and son of iconic Mexican former three-weight world champion Julio Cesar Chavez Sr.

Now 39, the Mexican is still fighting, though two of his last three bouts have come against MMA fighters in Uriah Hall and Anderson Silva. He last fought a fully-fledged boxer in December 2021, outpointing Peru’s David Zegarra over 10 rounds.
