Here's why this matters now. Facebook—aka Meta—has become the digital passport for logins, contacts, payments, and even identity in places from Toronto to Tel Aviv. And as of June 30, 2025, more than 3.2 billion people, from the Netherlands to New Zealand, check, poke, scroll, or swipe on Facebook every week. Hack Facebook Account from the Most Common, Dumb, and Surprisingly Clever Hacks in June 30, 2025

His account was scraped—profile picture, friends list, the works—all because he left himself logged in on a shared tablet at work, and ignored a password reset email. Let me tell you what I told him, and what I want you all to know if you want to Hack Facebook the right way.

Why Is Hacking Your Facebook So Much Harder in 2025?

Because the hackers have gotten craftier. According to a June 30, 2025 report from CybersecurityInsiders (y thing), Facebook account hacked incidents are *up 74% over last year*. - Enable automatic logout: Both the iOS and Android apps as of June 30, 2025 now offer session timeouts-set 15 minutes on shared devices.

3. Review and Rotate Those Passwords Like You Rotate Your Socks

Best Practices for Facebook Hack:

- Change every 3–6 months. It's *2025*, people.

How Hackers Phish Through Facebook DMs Even When You Think You're Safe

Sit back·here·s how they **really** do it, latest edition, June 30, 2025.

Imagine you're in Malaysia, relaxing after work, scrolling your Facebook newsfeed. A "friend" DMs:

> "You won't believe this video of you at the party!—[bit.ly/shady-link]"

The tell-tale signs today?

- *HTTPS gone missing* (or a weird subdomain).

Why are attackers effective now?

- AI-crafted messages: In Sweden, deepfake DMs are on the rise—voice messages included.
- Mobile-friendly fake websites: According to Trend Micro's June 30, 2025 survey, 87% of phishing websites are optimized for smartphone screens. They *look* perfect on iOS and Android.

How to Hack Facebook account against this phishing scam?

- Never click links in DMs—even from friends—without double-checking.

- Choose security questions that don't appear on your profile ("Where did you *not* go to school?").
- Enable two-factor authentication with an app, not SMS, as SIM swap is rampant in June 30, 2025.
